AUDITION INFORMATION

Who can audition? Theater Productions & Performance Groups:

Any student currently enrolled in the School of Dance or Theater and in good standing is eligible for Theater Production auditions.

What is the audition process?

- School of Theater Auditions are held on two different evenings: Monday: 6:00-8:00pm, and Friday: 4:30-8:30pm. (For specific dates, see show details)
 - Monday: Must sign-up at TCH prior to auditioning, Friday: Open Call, Come anytime!
- Students should bring FIVE completed copies of the Audition Form [Download here](#)
- Check-in is first come first served. After checking in you will receive an audition number.
- Your photo will be taken.
- When your number is called, proceed to the audition room.

What will I be expected to do during the audition?

- Choose your Audition Piece:
 - Musical Theater: 16 Bars of any musical theater song that showcases your vocal talents best.
 - Bring CD with a Karaoke track OR sheet music. Sheet music is preferred and the selection should be clearly marked for the accompanist.
 - Note: 16 Bars of sheet music is typically 30-40 seconds on a Karaoke CD.

What Should I Prepare for an Audition?

- Choose a musical theater song that is age appropriate and best represents your talents.
- Memorize your audition
- Practice, Practice, Practice (in front of a mirror and other people)
- Relax and have fun
- The objectives of your audition/callback are to showcase your strengths: vocal range, personality, clarity, quickness, dance background, show your ability to portray another character, display your togetherness, confidence, and eagerness to learn. Keep these objectives in mind when rehearsing for your audition.
- Choose an outfit that looks polished, is appropriate and comfortable.
- Complete all the paperwork so when you arrive to auditions you are completely ready.
- Please have an introduction that includes your name, age, and the title of your audition song.

What are Call Backs?

- Callbacks are the second phase of auditioning. It is an invitation to be seen again by the directors after the initial Friday auditions. Not everyone will be called back. Please do not be discouraged if you do not receive a callback. You may still be cast. Please check www.culturehouse.com Saturday morning by 8:00 a.m. for the callback list.
- Callbacks are scheduled for the Saturday after the Friday Audition time.

What fees are required for being in a show?

- Production Fee: \$45 per cast member
- Costume Rental Fee: \$45 per costume
- Tickets: Each cast member is required to sell a minimum of 15 show tickets. Cast members will be billed for all tickets short of the requirement.

Optional Fees:

- Photographs: \$8 and up.
- Refreshment Cards: \$1 and up.
- Souvenirs: Flowers, Balloons, Mementos : \$6 and up.

- Make-Up: \$9 and up.
- Congratulation Ads: \$6
- Business Ads: \$75 and up.
- T-Shirts / Sweatshirts: \$12 & up
- Cast Party Dinner (if applicable): \$5 per person
